Canterbury's fascinating history flows through all the major epochs of national and global importance. Roman Canterbury was an important city that linked the Kentish coast with London and beyond. Anglo-Saxon Canterbury was the base of the re-Christianisation of Britain and the Kingdom of Kent borders are those that define the modern county of Kent.

As the centre of religious and political turmoil, Canterbury has seen murder, the Reformation and Civil War. Events that have helped define today's city. The modern era has seen the ancient city need to evolve, with development and cultural heritage coming to the forefront following damage sustained during the Second World War.
